Mr. Dasaro is very concerned about your letter to him of September 10th inasmuch as he has been planning to use this property for many years as a residence.

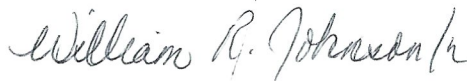
Without knowing all the facts, it seems to me quite unusual for a town to condemn land for a cemetery which borders on a lake. All of us who have been practicing law in New Hampshire in recent years have recognized the skyrocketing values of lake shore property and it would seem sensible to allow this land to be developed for recreational purposes rather than used as a cemetery.

I would appreciate it if you would consult with the selectmen and advise them of Mr. Dasaro's desire to contest any taking of his land. Also express to them the fact that it would appear to be a misuse of valuable real estate for a public purpose.

I would appreciate your sending all further correspondence concerning this matter to me and I will forward it on to Mr. Dasaro for his consideration.
