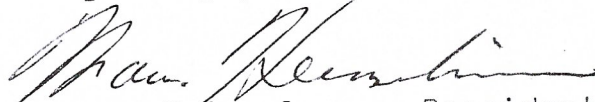

Dear Mr. Papademas:

Mr. Joseph Dasaro, a member of the Property Owners Association of Stocker Lake, has informed us of your request to him to sell part of his waterfront property to the Town of Grantham for the extension of a cemetery.

This is to advise you that the membership of the Association objects strongly to such action. The lake has been and continues to be developed as a recreational colony. The use of a large portion of one side of the lake as a burial ground would tend to reduce the value of our homes and make resale difficult. Also, removal of waterfront property from the tax polls would have a tendency to increase taxes generally. It would appear to the Association that the search for land for cemetery use should lie on areas other than those developed for recreational purposes. Mr. Dasaro has assured us he will contest this action and the membership is unanimous in its support.
